QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

On March 22, 2012, we received the following inquiry:

"When are the anointed retrieved to the sky, and are some anointed live on earth for a thousand years. Should they stay in the camp of Revelation 20:9?"

To the author, we thank you for your inquiry. We elected to separate this question from your previous question today so that we can give each inquiry a fair response.

In this inquiry, you are actually asking three separate and distinct questions. We will respond to each one separately:

(1) When are the anointed retrieved to the sky?

If you have read our previous responses, you will note that we never provide an answer to a question about when some Biblical or prophetic event will occur. We simply do not know and we chose not to speculate. What we can tell you is that if you are faithfully making your calling sure, when that time arrives, you will be on the favorable side of events.

(2) Are some anointed live on earth for a thousand years?

As you know, our belief, based on the Bible, is that all Christians have the heavenly hope. That would necessarily mean that any Christian on earth during the thousand years referred to in Relevation has that hope and will eventually attain to it. We are aware that there is some indication that new scrolls will be opened, but we have no idea what those scrolls will say. However, based on the "scrolls" that we do have, we believe there will always be anointed Christians on earth as a group until they individually attain to their heavenly calling.

(3) Should they stay in the camp of Revelation 20:9?

The answer to this questions is contained right within the scripture. It reads:

"And they advanced over the breadth of the earth and encircled the camp of the holy ones and the beloved city. **But fire came down out of heaven and devoured them.**" – *Revelation 20:9*
