Dear Brothers,

Yesterday, we published a new article entitled **Bringing Heaven Down – Turning Back Destruction**. A link to the article can be found on the **Update Page** of our site: www.AnointedJW.org. This article lays out a solid basis for an alternate view of man's future based on what we call 'The Ninevite Possibility.'

The Ninevite Possibility is the hope that any foretold destruction of our present day system of things can be averted by repentance and works befitting repentance as it did in the case of the Ninevites, as told by the prophet Jonah. The article posits that our Father is not interested in destruction; His real interest is salvation, as Jesus explained:

“For God loved the world so much that he gave his only-begotten Son, in order that everyone exercising faith in him **might not be destroyed but have everlasting life**. For God sent forth his Son into the world, **not for him to judge the world, but for the world to be saved through him.**” – *John 3:16-17*

The article also asserts that the true good news of the kingdom would be appealing to the vast majority of mankind if it is presented in its plain and authentic form. We recall that the Father does say He will accomplish his goals ‘**Not by a military force, nor by power, but by my spirit**’ (*Zechariah 4:6*), the spirit that resides in each one of us. (*1 Corinthians 3:16; 1 Corinthians 6:19*) Anything less would be a disservice to the Father and to one another.

In response to the article, one of our brothers astutely wrote about the end time:

“The reason that no one knows the day or the hour is because God has not yet decided. How could anyone know something not yet decided?”

This is a profound thought that deserves sustained contemplation for if he is correct, which we believe he is, the ministry of Jehovah's Witnesses should take on a more positive character. And a Circuit Overseer wrote:

“We should be preaching with the purpose of turning back the anger and wrath of Jehovah rather than looking forward to it. If you really care for those in the field, the prayer should be for more time not hurry up and end this thing so I can have a better life.”
