"Therefore, to the older men among you I give this exhortation, for I too am an older man with [them] and a witness of the sufferings of the Christ, a sharer even of the glory that is to be revealed: Shepherd the flock of God in your care, not under compulsion, but willingly; neither for love of dishonest gain, but eagerly; **neither as lording it over those who are God's inheritance**, but becoming examples to the flock. And when the chief shepherd has been made manifest, you will receive the unfadable crown of glory." – 1 Peter 5:1-4
